On September 13, 2010, the Governor's Commission on Supplier Diversity approved the department's effort to streamline its recertification process. Please remember you must notify us immediately if any changes occur. Failure to notify us of changes or to provide an ACE form annually will result in revocation of your certification. Changes include, but are not limited to, changes in location, contact information, ownership and control.

It is important that you review and update your profile regularly, because state purchasing agents and prime contractors may use this information to contact you for business opportunities.


